Information

The Krome Educational Fund was established by William H. and Phoebe Krome to help individuals with farmworker backgrounds, and their children, attain a higher standard of living than that into which they were born. The Fund will accomplish its purpose by providing financial assistance with the expenses of college education to those who otherwise could not attend college. An award, up to \$2,500, is given to the individual(s) selected. Redlands Christian Migrant Association (RCMA) administers the Fund under guidelines established by the RCMA Board of Directors.

Eligibility

A scholarship from the Krome Educational Fund is available to individuals who are:

- 1) An employee of RCMA (minimum three years) at the time of their application and a former farmworker, or
- 2) Children of those employees of RCMA, or
- 3) Children of other farmworkers, if the children have been cared for in some manner by RCMA (i.e. alumni)

Grants

Grants will be made for no more than one academic period (term or semester). Grantees may reapply for up to three additional periods following the normal application process. The Designees may specify that an award winner will be considered for renewal of the award for *up to three academic periods*. Subsequent period grants will be conditioned on continuous enrollment during the academic year, satisfactory completion of all coursework with a cumulative 2.5 GPA or better, and continuing financial need, among other factors.

Application Instructions

Completed applications must be submitted, received via email or postmarked **by May 5, 2023**. Applicants will be notified of determination **by end of May 2023**. **IMPORTANT:** Incomplete applications will not be accepted.
