

Krome Educational Fund Scholarship Application

Information

The Krome Educational Fund was established by William H., Phoebe, Medora Krome to help individuals with farmworker backgrounds and their children attain a higher standard of living than that into which they were born. The Fund will accomplish its purpose by providing financial assistance with college education expenses to those who otherwise could not attend college. An award of up to \$2,500 is given to the individual(s) selected. Redlands Christian Migrant Association (RCMA) administers the Fund under guidelines established by the RCMA Board of Directors.

Eligibility

A scholarship from the Krome Educational Fund is available to individuals who are:

- 1) An employee of RCMA (minimum three years) at the time of their application and a former farmworker or
- 2) Children of those employees of RCMA, or
- 3) Children of other farmworkers, if the children have been cared for in some manner by RCMA (i.e. alumni)

Returning Applicants

Returning applicants are expected to reapply to be considered for the next term or semester scholarship using the Krome Educational Fund Scholarship Application. Letters of Recommendation are not required to be resubmitted. In addition to the completed application, **include a copy of your unofficial transcripts up to date.**

Grants

Grants will be made for no more than one academic period (term or semester). Grantees may reapply for a total of three additional periods following the normal application process. The Designees may specify that an award winner will be considered for renewal of the award for **a total of three academic periods**. Subsequent period grants will be conditioned on continuous enrollment during the academic year, satisfactory completion of all coursework with a cumulative 2.5 GPA or better, and continuing financial need, among other factors.

Application Instructions

Completed applications must be submitted, received via email or postmarked **by May 1, 2026**. Applicants will be notified of determination **by May 29, 2026**. **IMPORTANT: Incomplete applications will not be accepted.**
